LIBRARY

The mission of the SJR State Library is to provide quality services, instruction, and resources which support the mission of St. Johns River State College and meet the informational, educational, cultural, and lifelong learning needs of the College community. There is a library located on each campus.

Each campus library provides study areas, leisure seating, computers & Wi-Fi for current students, printers, scanners, reserve collections, and open stack shelving for circulating collections. The librarians and staff at each campus library provide personalized research and citation help in-person or online, workshops and library instruction in-person or online, customized course content for faculty, access to the SJR State Library's digital collections of articles, ebooks, and streaming videos, loans of books & DVDs, hold requests for in-demand items, and campus, state & nationwide inter-library loan services.

Current students, faculty, and staff may access the library's online catalog and digital collections 24/7 via the "Library" tab in MySJRstate. Instructional materials are available on the library's LibGuides site (<http://libraries.sjrstate.edu/>). Online reference services are provided via the statewide Ask-a-Librarian service which offers research assistance via chat, text, or email. Access to Ask-a-Librarian is provided via MySJRstate and LibGuides.
