

SJR State Program List

St. Johns River State College offers programs at the certificate, associate and baccalaureate level. Each program is identified in the *College Catalog* with a four-digit program number. Programs are also assigned a six digit CIP (Classification of Instructional Programs) code for reporting program completions to IPEDS (Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System).

Table 1 lists programs in the most recent college catalog. Table 2 lists programs that are either on abeyance or in teach out mode. In all cases the Federal six-digit CIP is included. Table 2 does not include current programs that were listed in prior catalogs with different program numbers. An example would be the AS degree in Accounting Technology which currently has a program number of 0093 but formerly had a program number of 0092. Both 0092 and 0093 have the same Federal six-digit CIP and identical program learning outcomes.
