## Vikings fall to Chipola, come back vs. Hillsborough

The St. Johns River State College softball team gave everything it had against the No. 1 team in the state Saturday at home.

It wasn't enough in the end as the Vikings lost 6-0 to 20-0 Chipola College. After Chipola beat Hillsborough in the next game, 8-1, the Vikings came back to defeat Hillsborough in the final game of the day, 10-2.

In the opener, Barbara Woll did the damage for Chipola, going 3-for-4 with a run scored and three RBI, delivering a two-run home run in the fourth inning against losing pitcher Ariel McCullough (9-3), who went the whole way, giving up seven hits, walking none and striking out three.

While Woll was a thorn to the side of the Vikings at the plate, in the circle, Krystal Goodman (7-0) was hard to hit. She walked one and struck out nine, while scattering three hits, singles to Maegan Stone and Reganne McCarl and a double to Selena Bezares.

In the nightcap, Brooklynn Basile had the big game, going 2-for-3 with a run scored and three-run home run home run, her first of the year, during a seven-run third inning. Selena Nunez was 2-for-3 with a run scored and two runs scored and Karsyn Barnes went 2-for-3 with a run scored. Bezares was 2-for-2 with two RBI. Kelsea Friend, Stone, Morgan Scala, McCarl and Jaime Valenta each had one hit for the Vikings, who at 15-6 have their best record ever as a program after 21 games.
