### COLLEGE SOFTBALL

#### Vikings 0-6 in conference after sweep

Allie Geiger delivered a five-hit shutout and Ashlyn Allen belted a solo home run in leading the Lake-Sumter College softball team to a 6-0 win in the first game of a Mid-Florida Conference doubleheader Saturday at St. Johns River State College.

The LakeHawks won the nightcap, 9-3, behind a 3-for-3 performance by Allen in the second game.

In the opener, Allen's home run in the third inning against losing pitcher Maddie Tomas (7-5) would turn out to be the only run Geiger would need. Geier (7-4) walked two, scattered five hits and struck out six. Jennifer Bryant went 2-for-3 with a run to lead the LakeHawks (19-21 overall, 2-6 in the conference).

In the second game, Abbey Primavera also allowed five hits, walked one and struck out one. For the doubleheader, Amanda Quinby, the 2018 Putnam County player of the year from Interlachen High, was 0-for-5, but scored twice and drove in a run.

For the Vikings (11-19, 0-6), Jaime Valenta hit a solo home run in the second game, her first of the year, and had a hit in each game. Taylor Finney had an RBI single in the second game bringing in Abby Ferlin, who had a hit in each game, and Harli Phillips scored on a passed ball. Cardaejia Talley had a hit in each game, while Kendell Moody and Tomas had a hit each in the first game and Basile had a second-game hit.

The Vikings host Seminole State (26-10, 5-1) in a conference doubleheader at 4 p.m. today.
