## Vikings sweep, make it 5 straight

The best offensive showing of the year helped continue the winning ways for the St. Johns River State College volleyball team on Friday.

The Vikings put down 46 kills and held off Sun-Lakes Conference rival South Florida State College, 25-19, 25-17, 25-19, at Tuten Gymnasium to improve their winning streak to five.

"We really struggled to get them out of their system with our serve," Vikings coach Matt Cohen said after his team improved to 9-4 overall and 2-0 in the conference, "but we were really good offensively. There were a number of things that weren't quite right, but offensively, we were right there. We averaged 15 kills per set and usually we are averaging 10 or 11, so that's how I knew that was our best of the year."

Kendal Hoges led the way for the Vikings with 12 kills, while Eden Edgell had nine kills and Louisa Marunde put up eight kills and had an ace. Jordyn Pruski handed out 39 assists and Dariana Luna came up with 13 digs and two aces.

The Vikings will travel to Trinity College for a match Tuesday before their big showdown Wednesday night at Gulf Coast State, the other unbeaten team in the Sun-Lakes Conference at 2-0.

South Florida slipped to 2-5 overall and 1-3 in the conference.
