South Florida upends Vikings

For the first time this year, the St. Johns River State College volleyball team came up on the short end of a Sun-Lakes conference match. The Vikings dropped a 25-22, 25-19, 17-25, 25-21 decision to South Florida College at Avon Park on Friday.

"South Florida played really well," Cohen said after his team dropped to 17-6 overall and 6-1 in the conference, leaving them tied at the top in the loss column with Gulf Coast State College, which is 4-1 in conference play. "We struggled to get into a rhythm defensively."

For the Vikings, which swept South Florida in a match at Tuten Gymnasium on Sept. 20, Louisa Marunde had 15 kills, Kendal Hoges put down 13 kills and Lucy Herter added 11 kills. Dariana Luna came up with 19 digs and setter Jordyn Pruski, the NJCAA Division II Offensive Player of the Week last week, handed out 43 assists.
