
St. Johns River State College Career Pathways Scholarship 2019-2020

Procedures for Applying:

Submit the following documents which must be **received** by the deadline of **April 1, 2019**:

1. SJR State Admission Application on-line: <http://www.sjrstate.edu/admissions.html>.
(Dual Enrollment students must complete the update application)
2. SJR State Career Pathways Scholarship Application
3. Current Official High School transcript
4. The results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
❖ *SJR State must have the FAFSA results by the application deadline, apply early.*

Eligibility and Renewal Requirements:

The applicant must be a 2019 graduate of a SACS accredited high school in Clay, Putnam or St. Johns County. The applicant must have a minimum unweighted overall grade point average of 2.8 and a minimum unweighted grade point average of 3.0 in the Career Pathways program of study.

Application deadline is **April 1, 2019**. Late submissions will not be considered. For eligible programs of study visit: <http://www.sjrstate.edu/workforce/careerpathways.html>

Scholarship Amount:

The amount of this scholarship is valued at the value of 30 credit hours multiplied by the in-state tuition and fee rate. The scholarship can be used for tuition, lab, and other fees, but is limited to the amount stated. You must enroll three-quarter time (9 credit hours) or full-time (12 credit hours or more) during the Fall and Spring Terms to receive the scholarship. Any remaining amount of the scholarship not used during the Fall or Spring terms may be used in the Summer Term.

Renewals:

Students who receive scholarships for the 2019-2020 year will be eligible to continue on scholarship for additional years of college not to exceed the total number of credits required for the A.S. degree or certificate program declared. For renewal, students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 on a minimum of 18 credit hours earned for the Fall and Spring Terms in an A.S. Degree or Certificate Program. Requests for exceptions to the hours completed requirement may be considered by the Scholarship Committee.

In order to be considered for scholarship renewal, the scholarship recipient must notify the Director of Financial Aid in writing of his/her intent to return to SJR State College by **April 1** of each year.
