Question 2: What is the term length of the contract going to be for this?

Question 3: Who is the current incumbent?

Answer: Overwatch Security Group, Inc.

Question 4: When was the current incumbent awarded the contract?

Answer: May 18, 2021

Question 5: Could you please provide us copy of current contract?

Question 6: Are there any subcontractors being used for the current contract?

Answer: No



Question 7: What was the initial term length of the current contract (for example, 1 year plus 4 year options, etc.)?

Answer: Original RFP Language: the successful bidder will enter into a contract with the College based on the RFP specifications and their proposal for a period of twelve (12) months. SJR State has the option and reserves the right to extend the contract beyond the initial twelve (12) month period for three (3) additional twelve (12) month periods by mutual consent of the parties. This option does not prohibit SJR State from declining to enact the option to renew for any subsequent period(s). Notice of intent concerning renewal is anticipated 60 days prior to the end of the current term. Anticipated contract start date is July 1, 2021.

Question 8: What was the start date of the initial contract?

Answer: July 1, 2021

Question 9: What was the amount spent on this contract last year?

Answer: \$507,969.22

Question 10: What was the total spent in the last billed month?

Answer: \$32,225.75

Question 11: Are there any other rates billed separately (e.g., equipment, vehicles, etc.)?

Answer: No

Question 12: Are there any significant modifications from the previous contract to the new one? For instance, an increase in hours, a change in guard type (e.g., armed vs unarmed), a need for additional resources?

Answer: Minor changes were made to the insurance requirements (Section 6.11 of the RFP

Question 13: What is the estimated total number of annual hours for this contract?

Answer: 25,250 est

Question 14: What is the current bill rate for each position?

Answer: \$21 Guard, \$22 Supervisor



Question 15: Are there any additional services that may be needed that are not listed in the RFP? For instance, the need of additional sites, seasonal required security, etc.

Answer: Staff hours will be adjusted to accommodate full-time officers on vacations, holidays, school closures like weather events, or lack of student body on campus.

WTC would be four (4) eight (8) hour days in Summer A, and no hours for Summer B.

In Palatka additional staff may be required when accommodating unexpected staff shortages.

Additionally, services required for the WTC location will be for one (1) year.

Question 16: Beyond the state and federal minimum wage, is there a prevailing wage, living wage ordinance, local mandated wage, or contract-specific wage?

Answer: No, other than the minimum required in the RFP

Question 17: 2.11 BOND: A bond may be required to guarantee the payment of any losses by theft, burglary, pilfering or vandalism as a result of carelessness, negligence or willful acts of the Contractor, its agents, employees or assigns. This states a Bond "may be required", is a bond required for the proposal?

Answer: No

Question 18: Is a vehicle needed and/or is currently being used on the contract?

Answer: No

Question 19: Are there armed and unarmed positions?

Answer: No, there are no unarmed positions currently on any of our campuses.

Question 20: What are the numbers of personnel needed for Palatka and Orange Park? It appears there's a need for two.

Answer: The officers' hours overlap for about an hour therefore the need is for one.

Question 21: Will there need to be an officer on Friday in Palatka?

Answer: No, Palatka uses non-contracted officers.




- (A) CLASSROOM BUILDING A


MASTER FACILITY PLAN




