

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The District Board of Trustees of St. Johns River State College will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 21, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Administration Building on the Palatka Campus, 5001 St. Johns Avenue, Palatka, FL 32177. In addition to the regular agenda, which may include, but is not limited to, business affairs, personnel matters, facilities items and academic and student affairs, the District Board of Trustees will also adopt the student tuition and fee schedule for the upcoming 2017-18 academic year.

Florida Statute 1009.23(1) grants authority to Florida College System institutional boards of trustees to establish tuition and fees within a range allowed by state statute. The proposed tuition and fee schedule will hold all rates at the current level except for the capital improvement fee for lower division college credit and baccalaureate courses. Beginning Fall Term 2017, the proposed change to this fee would be a reduction of \$2.00 per credit hour. This reduction would result in the total tuition and fee rate changing from \$110 per credit hour to \$108 per credit hour for lower division college credit courses. For baccalaureate level courses, the reduction would change the total tuition and fee rate from \$126.75 to \$124.75 per credit hour. The \$2.00 reduction in the capital improvement fee would also be applied to the non-resident student fee schedule.
