

The District Board of Trustees of St. Johns River State College will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 20, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Administration Building, on the Palatka campus, 5001 St. Johns Ave. Palatka, Florida. In addition to the regular agenda, which may include, but is not limited to, business affairs, personnel matters, facilities items and academic and student affairs, the District Board of Trustees will also consider a decrease in the laboratory fees for uniform charges in certain Criminal Justice courses.

Florida Statute 1009.23(12)(a) grants authority to Florida College System institutional boards of trustees to establish fees within a range allowed by state statute. These fees “shall not exceed the cost of services provided and shall only be charged to persons receiving the service.” In order to comply with this legislation, SJR State created a specific institutional policy and procedure that governs the creation, review and adjustment of fees. The review process includes an analysis of the actual paid enrollment for the course(s) and the allowable expenditures related to the course(s).

Proposed fee changes will be considered for the following Criminal Justice courses beginning in the 2018-19 academic year (course number - current rate – new rate without uniform cost – potential new rate with uniform cost):

(CJK0001 - \$514 - \$8 - \$368); (CJK0300 - \$512 - \$5 - \$365)

The uniforms will be available at each campus bookstore and may be included in either the new lab fee rate or available for purchase by each student enrolled in the above courses.

Estimated economic impact on all affected persons cannot be determined.
