3. Amendment to SJR Rule 1.32 – Core Values for the Thrasher-Horne Center for the Arts
4. Amendment to SJR Rule 5.03(A)(R1) – Revocation, Suspension and/or Dismissal of Individuals on Continuing Contract or Annual Contract or Adjunct Faculty
5. Amendment to SJR Rule 5.13(R2) – Instructional Personnel Policies on Duties, Teaching Load and Hours of Work
