



How AICE Credit Articulates to College Credit at SJR State

Please use the information below in conjunction with the Credit by Exam Equivalencies document on the Florida Department of Education's web site (www.fldoe.org/policy/articulation) to determine how AICE credit articulates to college credit at SJR State.

The listing below provides information for AICE exams that are commonly submitted to SJR State. If the exam you have taken is not listed below, please consult the chart (www.fldoe.org/policy/articulation) to determine equivalency.

- Design and Technology (AS-Level): ETI E482C, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- English (A Level): Total of 6 credits - ENC 1101, 3 credits and ENC 1102, 3 credits (General Education Communications)
- English (A-Level) Literature in English – If the student has credit for ENC 1101 and ENC 1102, (General Education Communications) then they are awarded LIT 2100, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- Foreign Language: SJR State will give credit for the beginning level foreign language that we offer. Example: SPN 1120 (Elective Credit)
- General Paper: IDS E110, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- Global Perspectives 1 (AS-Level): ISS 1011, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- History: Credit would be determined by which History exam was taken by the student.
- Marine Science (AS-Level): OCE E001, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- Marine Science (A-Level): Total of 7 credits - OCE E001, 3 credits (Elective Credit) and OCB 1000/OCB 1000L, 4 credits (General Education Science)
- Thinking Skills (AS-Level): PHI E103, 3 credits (Elective Credit)
- Thinking Skills (A-Level): Total of 6 credits - PHI E103, 3 credits (Elective Credit) and PHI 2010, 3 credits (General Education Humanities)
