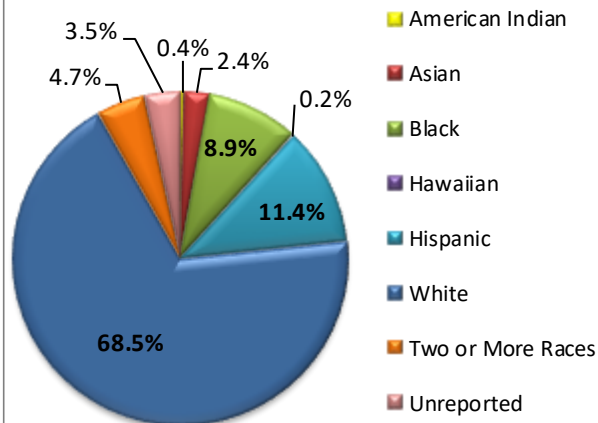

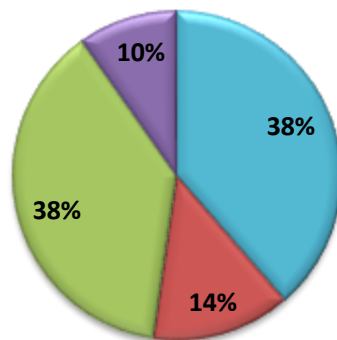
Enrollment by Ethnicity/Race Fall 2019

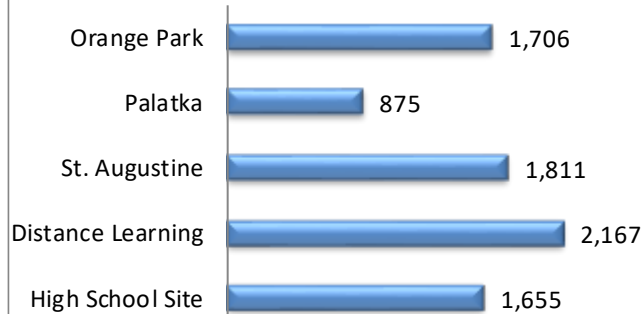

Unduplicated Headcount by Predominant Campus Fall 2019



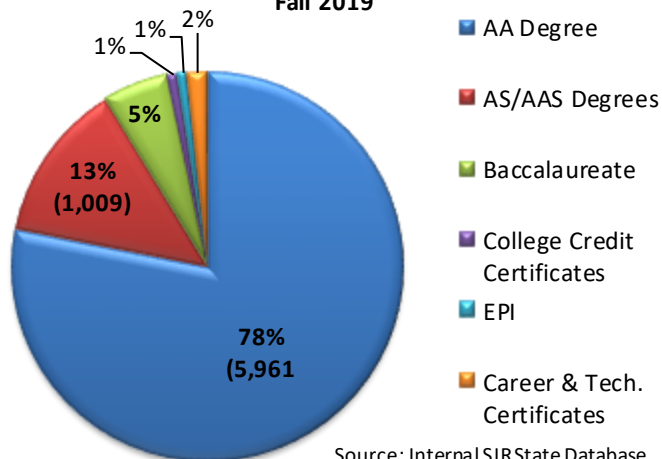
