With the increase in active shooter incidents, officers never know when they may find themselves in a situation where they will need to confront an active shooter as a single responder. In these situations, the priority is to stop the threat; waiting for backup is not an option. This course is designed to help prepare a single officer, especially a School Resource Officer (SRO) to respond to an active shooter incident when they find themselves the first line of defense during an incident.
